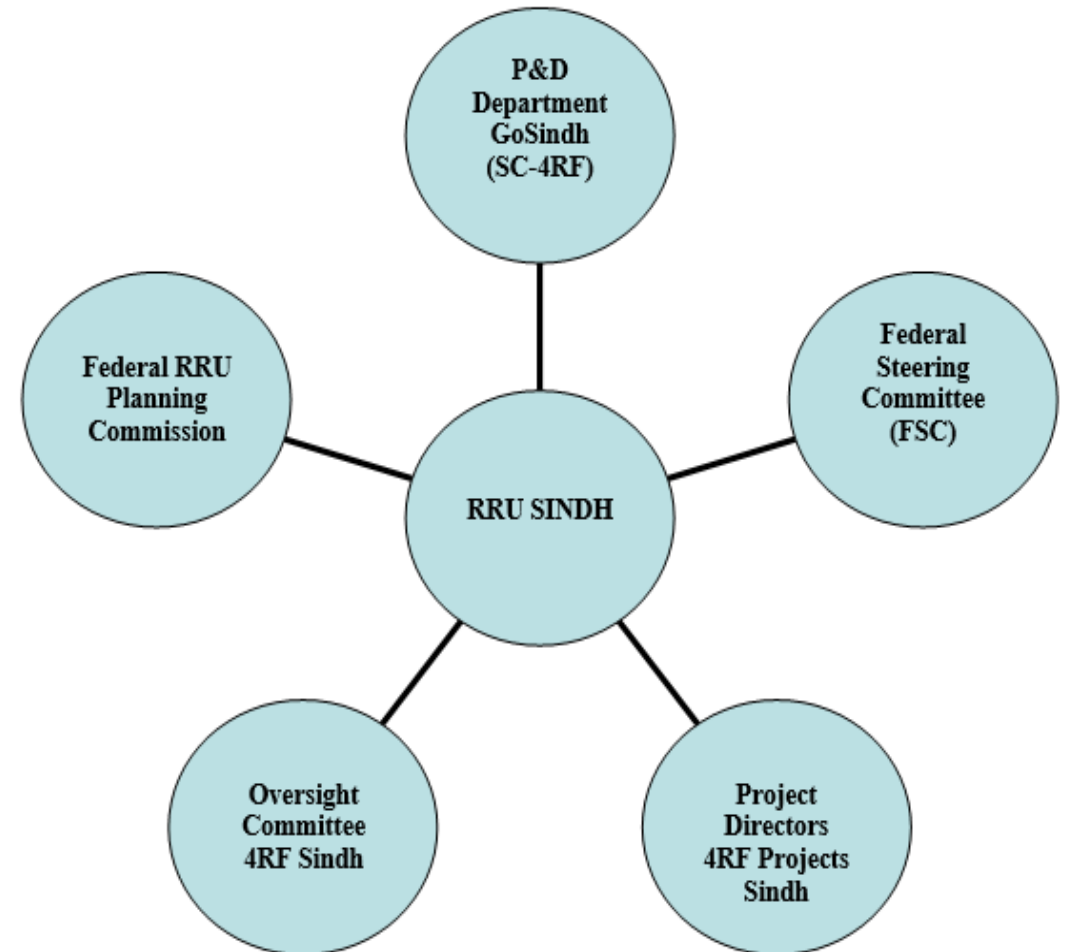
Background:

Recovery & Reconstruction Unit (RRU) Sindh has been established at PCMU - Directorate of Sindh Water & Barrages Improvement vide P&D Department's notification dated 28th March, 2024 for providing coordination support and implementation facility to all Project Directors of post floods 4RF Projects in Sindh.

Purpose/Tasks:

- ❑ Provide project preparation support and implementation facility to post flood project implementing departments / agencies.
- ❑ Boost up progress of ongoing post flood projects in Sindh through oversight committee headed by Chief Economist, P&D Department.
- ❑ Bridge between federal and provincial government setup of 4RF for providing coordination support and facilitate all Project Directors of post floods projects in Sindh in case any guidance is required in procurement and financial management matters.
- ❑ Serve as Secretariat of 4RF Provincial Steering Committee headed by Chairman P&D Board.

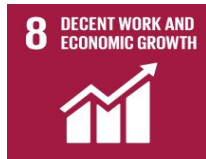

Progress/Achievements of Current Month – September, 2025:

- ❑ A virtual Consultative Session on the 4RF SRO Provincial Results Framework was organized by UNDP (Islamabad) on September 16, 2025, to deliberate on the issues and challenges being faced by 4RF projects in Sindh. The session was chaired by the Advisor M&E, UNDP, and attended by officials from RRU Sindh, along with teams from all 4RF projects in the province.
- ❑ As per the urgent request of the Federal RRU, the 4RF Projects Funds Allocation Status was collected, updated, and verified by all 4RF Project Directors in Sindh on September 26, 2025, and subsequently forwarded to Federal RRU on the same day.
- ❑ In pursuance of PD&DI, GoP Letter No. F. No. 11(7)/RRU/PDSI/2022 dated October 2, 2025, a meeting has been scheduled on Wednesday, October 8, 2025, at 2:00 PM in this office to discuss the Provincial 4RF Outcomes and the SRO Results Framework under the 4RF Framework.

Progress/Achievements of Current Month - August-2025:

- ❑ Actively coordinated, facilitated, and consulted with 4RF PDs, the Planning & Development Department, Government of Sindh and the Federal RRU for the development and implementation of a province-based (4RF) Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) Framework, aimed at integration with the Federal Level.
- ❑ An urgent Coordination and Consultation Session on recent 2025 Flood Damage and Needs Assessment was held on September 1, 2025, under the chairmanship of the Member I&RC, Ministry of Planning, Development, and Special Initiatives. The officials from the P&D Department, RRU Sindh, and teams from all 4RF projects in Sindh participated the session virtually.
- ❑ A 4RF projects progress review meeting was held on August 13, 2025, organized by Ministry of Planning, Development, and Special Initiatives virtually under the Chairmanship of Director General of the Federal RRU. The officials of P&D Department, RRU Sindh and teams of all 4RF projects in Sindh participated the meeting.
- ❑ 15/08/2025: Circulated Minutes of 2nd Meeting of PSC – 4RF Projects held on 25/06/2025 under Chairmanship of Chairman P&D Board, Government of Sindh.
- ❑ 12/08/2025: Circulated Minutes of 5th Meeting of Oversight Committee of 4RF Projects held on 27/07/2025 under chaired by CE, P&D Department.

Progress/Achievements of the Month of July-2025:

- ❑ The Fifth meeting of the Oversight Committee of 4RF was held on 17th July 2025 in the Committee room of P&D Department, Karachi. The meeting chaired by Mr. Mohammad Aslam Soomro, Chief Economist / Convenor of the Committee, P&D Department, Government of Sindh.
 - The Committee reviewed implementation progress (Financial and Physical) of projects that come under the umbrella of 4RF/ RRU Sindh.
 - The committee also discussed the Implementation and Reporting Mechanism of M&E Framework for each Project, followed by the development of Province-based framework required by the Federal RRU.
 - Minutes of Meeting prepared and submitted for approval of Chairman.
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- ❑ The Provincial RRU Sindh facilitated the team of federal RRU for arranging the capacity building workshop on Project Planning and Management held on July 23, 2025, at Karachi. Mr. Nazeer Ahmed Memon, Project Coordinator, PCMU / RRU Sindh, participated as the chief guest of the event.
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- ❑ Followed by a workshop, a meeting of the Provincial RRU Sindh Working Group was held on July 24, 2025, in the Committee room of the PCMU, P&D Department, Government of Sindh, Karachi. Chief Economist chaired the meeting and participated by the Federal RRU team, UNDP, Project Directors, along with M&E Specialists, and presented and discussed the project-specific M&E Framework.
